The City of Dayton has received questions relating to our IFB No. 13048M

The following are the questions with answers for this IFB. Please consider this document in preparation of your bid response. In the answers of these questions the City of Dayton shall be noted as "City".

**New Due Date and Time: 4:00 P.M. local (Dayton, OH) time on June 18, 2013**

1. What is the difference between truck load deliveries and transport deliveries? (i.e. transport =18 wheeler truck / truck load =small truck)

**ANSWER (1): In the survey of our membership, we defined transport loads as deliveries made with semis with a tank trailer. The size of qualifying load varies with vendor. Truck loads were defined as deliveries made with smaller straight trucks with metered delivery.**

2. On the estimated quantities matrix that is in Attachment B, what does the MIN and MAX quantities stand for?

**ANSWER (2): The Min/Max quantities provided in Attachment B are the low and high quantities that SWOP4G received when surveying our potentially interested parties. In regards to Unleaded 87, for example, the highest estimated quantity usage provided by any one entity was 152,000 gallons, and the lowest estimated quantity usage by any one responsive entity was 18,995 gallons. Please keep in mind that these are estimated quantities, and no quantities are being guaranteed at this time.**
