Dear Prospective Bidders:

The following additions, deletions and/or changes to Project Number SO000028, SWOP4G Water Treatment Chemicals, are to be considered part of the original specifications and are equally binding.

1. Following are answers to submitted questions:

- a. **QUESTION:** What size and orientation (horizontal or vertical) are the tanks at Wright AFB and Sidney? **Answer: While Montgomery County has issued the bid for SWOP4G, each participating municipality will be required to enter into a formal contract with the vendor of their choice. Please follow-up with the contact person listed in the bid documents for Wright AFB and Sidney to obtain that information.**

- b. **QUESTION:** Do you anticipate extending the Bid due date: **ANSWER: Montgomery County will not extend the due date. Bids are due by no later than 1:30 p.m. on Wednesday, November 18, 2020, EST.**

- c. **QUESTION:** What additional details are you willing to provide, if any, beyond what is stated in bid documents concerning how you will identify the winning bid? **Answer: Montgomery County will evaluate all bids in accordance with Ohio Revised Code 307.86 in order to determine the "lowest and best" bid submitted. The Bid documents include all of the criteria which will be evaluated to determine the winning Bid.**

Each participating municipality of SWOP4G will evaluate the bid response in accordance with their jurisdiction's legal requirements.

- d. **QUESTION:** Was this bid posted to the nationwide free bid notification website at www.mygovwatch.com/free? **Answer: No.**
- e. **QUESTION:** Other than your own website, where was this bid posted? **Answer: In compliance with Ohio Revised Code 307.87 a Legal Notice was placed in the Dayton Daily News on 10/30/20 as well as listed on Montgomery County's Online Bid Website. The Bid will remain on the County's website for the duration of the solicitation period until the closing of the bid on November 18, 2020 at 1:30 p.m. The bid was also posted to the SWOP4G website at www.SWOP4G.org for the same time period.**
- f. **QUESTION:** Where can the bid tabulation/award information for the last release of this bid be found, or does a Freedom of Information Act/Right to Know request need to be submitted to have that info released? **ANSWER: A copy of the bid tabulation for the prior year's bid has been posted with the Addendum at www.mcoho.org/onlinebids.**
- g. **QUESTION:** Is the anticipated start date 12/1/20 or 1/1/21? **ANSWER: Montgomery County's anticipated contract start date is January 1, 2021 for the 2021 Water Treatment Chemical season. Each participating municipality will be required to enter into their own formal agreement with the chemical provider of their choice based on their internal evaluation of the bid tabulation provided.**
